# Mitigation Projects

- Independently solve a problem related to natural hazards
- Reduce the risk to life and property
- Are not a response, planning, replacement, or maintenance activity



# Applicant Eligibility

- Local governmental agency
- Special District
- Private Non-Profit (HMGP only)
- State Agency



# Planning Requirement

- Must have a FEMA approved Local Hazard Mitigation Plan at the time of application and award
- State agencies can use the State Plan
- Private Non-Profits (PNP) are not eligible in PDM
- PNPs must be in the geographic area of an agency with an approved LHMP



# Benefit Cost Analysis

- All project activities must be cost effective
- FEMA has a new Benefit Cost Toolkit
- Cal EMA provides training on BCA



# Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)

- Disaster Declaration Driven
- California receives 20% of PA and IA costs
- Up to 75% federal share.
- State Priorities for Planning and Project activity selection.
- Subject to the new HMA Guidance



# Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM)

- Annual funding
- Funds awarded on a national basis
- Ear Marks
- Applications are submitted electronically
- Up to 75% federal share with a 3 million dollar cap



# Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA)

- Intent is to reduce claims to NFIP
- Annual allocation to each state
- State priorities
- Focus is on elevations and acquisitions



# Severe Repetitive Loss (SRL)

- Residential property
- NFIP Participation
- Four NFIP claim payments of \$5,000 or more
- Two separate claims with cumulative amount of the building portion exceeding the market value
- At least two claims must have occurred within any 10-year period, and must be greater than 10 days apart
- Up to 90% federal share
